Main activity of the project:

Why a questionnaire?

- To check the awareness of the industry about current Smart Grid standardisation initiatives and existing standards
- To estimate the relevance of the standardisation works in progress based on the benefits expected by Industry
- To provide feedback to the standardisation committees on the actual use of their standards
- To identify standardisation requirements of the various actors in three concrete Smart Grid areas, as well as std gaps and required actions
- To identify best practices/solutions which are worth being considered in the standardisation
